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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
TRI-CITIES SOCCER REFEREES ASSOCIATION

I, the undersigned person, acting as the incorporator of a corporation under the provisions of the Washington Non-Profit Corporation Act (RCW 24.03), adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be TRI-CITIES SOCCER REFEREES ASSOCIATION.

ARTICLE II.

The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III.

The purpose(s) for which the organization is organized all lawful and empowered purposes and powers pursuant to RCW 24.03.035 as now exists or may be hereafter amended or substituted, and otherwise exclusively for charitable and educational purposes; including the advancement of education and the promotion of social welfare to combat juvenile delinquency; and including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

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ARTICLE IV.

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons; except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable fees for services rendered by members as soccer referees and linesmen and other associated services, and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on:

(a) By a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code; or

(b) By a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code

ARTICLE V.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes in the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding

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2 section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed
3 to the federal government, to a state or local government, for a
4 public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be
5 disposed of by the Superior Court of the county in which the
6 principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively
7 for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as
8 said court shall determine, which are organized and operated
9 exclusively for such purposes.

10 ARTICLE VI.

11 This corporation shall have members whose eligibility
12 and qualifications shall be determined by the By Laws of the
13 corporation.

14 ARTICLE VII.

15 The name of the initial registered agent of the
16 corporation is George Vondruska. The address of the initial
17 registered office of the corporation shall be 716 S. Dennis,
18 Kennewick, Washington 99336.

19 ARTICLE VIII.

20 The number of directors constituting the initial Board
21 of Directors of the corporation shall be three (3) directors.
